Please plan to attend the American Society of Functional Neuroradiology (ASFNR) 12th Annual Meeting to be held October 15-17, 2018 at the Hotel del Coronado in Coronado, California. An optional “hands-on” BOLD fMRI workshop will be conducted on October 14.

The ASFNR 12th Annual Meeting will provide attendees with an unparalleled opportunity to receive instruction in the rapidly evolving field of functional neuroimaging and related disciplines. The program will appeal to a multidisciplinary group of professionals interested in neuroimaging including: neuroradiologists, neurologists, neurosurgeons, medical physicists, biomedical engineers, neuropsychologists, cognitive neuroscientists, clinical and research fellows, residents, doctoral and postdoctoral students, and radiology technologists.

During the 2 ½ day meeting, educational opportunities will include lectures, panel discussions, oral research paper presentations, posters, and small study group sessions. Instruction will be provided by an outstanding group of internationally recognized experts in the field.

I’m pleased to announce that this year’s honorary lecturer will be Kamil Ugurbil, Ph.D. from the Center for Magnetic Resonance Research at the University of Minnesota. Dr. Ugurbil, known for his groundbreaking work in BOLD fMRI and ultrahigh field MR imaging, will be sharing insights and perspectives gained through his integral involvement with the Human Connectome Project and the NIH BRAIN initiative.

Additional highlights of this year’s program include:

- Updates on clinical BOLD fMRI for pre-surgical mapping including advanced anatomic considerations, multiband data acquisition, cerebral vascular reactivity imaging, and ultrahigh field fMRI.
- Advances in diffusion imaging including new applications of diffusion tensor imaging and other microstructural imaging techniques.
- New perspectives on cerebral perfusion imaging, radiogenomics, and other advanced methods of brain tumor analysis.
- An exploration of neuropsychiatric imaging.
- Best recommendations for advanced pediatric neuroimaging methods.
- A look into the quickly evolving role of artificial intelligence in neuroimaging.

This year, the popular pre-meeting ASFNR “Hands-On” BOLD fMRI data processing workshop, chaired by Dr. Scott Faro and Dr. Feroze Mohammed, will be expanded to include processing of resting state functional connectivity data. Enrollment is limited and demand is always high, so be sure to register early for this unique training opportunity.

The setting for this year’s meeting is the beautiful Hotel del Coronado, an iconic beach resort across the bay from the city of San Diego. A short 20-minute drive or taxi ride from the San Diego International Airport, the facility offers a tranquil seaside setting with several dining opportunities and a beautiful beach.
